Dear Parents,

Welcome to Tiny Tots Camp. The program begins at 9:00am and ends at 12:30pm at Pagels Elementary School located at 26 Benham Hill Rd.

Your Tiny Tot Camp Director is **Krystal Denny Fleming**

Each day we ask that you send a snack and beverage to camp with your child. Snacks should be as nutritious as possible and glass containers are not allowed. We do our best to maintain a peanut free program we would appreciate your cooperation with this matter. Please be sure your child wears sneakers. A bathing suit is needed for supervised sprinkler play and a waterslide. Keep a bottle of sunscreen at camp or in their backpack. Also, many children carry their belongings in similar backpacks; please clearly label all bags with your child's name. Although all campers need to be toilet trained, an extra set of clothing packed in case of other "emergencies" is very helpful.

The camp program is designed to meet the needs, interests, and capabilities of the preschool age group. The counselors are trained to provide a safe and enjoyable and fun environment for the children. The children are divided into small groups led by assigned counselors, but will also engage in some large group activities. The counselor to camper ratio is less than 1:5.

Activities include lots of socialization, play time (structured as well as free play), arts & crafts, sprinkler time, waterslide, games, and some special events.

Unfortunately, due to budget restrictions or issues that may arise after registration, schedules and events may change. You will be notified by mail of any changes before camp begins. If you do not hear from us, the schedule will run as planned. I hope the information in this letter is helpful to you. If you wish to discuss the camp further, please feel free to call me anytime, 937-3651.

P.S. Although, we ask that you be on time picking up your child, we do understand sometimes you may get delayed. We ask that you keep our office number, if you are going to be late we ask that you call they will contact the director. If you are continuously late you may be asked to leave the program. Please do your best to pickup on time. If someone other than the regular person is picking please let the director or your child's counselor know when dropping off your child in the a.m.

If there is anyone that should NOT pickup your child, please give this person's name to our director.
